Class Attire Policy

Dancers who are not properly dressed will not be allowed to participate in class. All dancers are expected to adhere to studio policy regarding proper attire. Studio leotards are provided to all students as part of the registration fee and are to be worn for all subjects.

Dancers will not be permitted to wear costume style skirts/tutus since it is a distraction to other dancers. In addition our 3 and 4 year old classes will not be allowed to wear dance skirts to class since it is a distraction. Kindergarten classes may wear black see through skirts.

Class appropriate shoes are also required for each subject taken. Satin or fabric slippers typically found at discount stores are a hazard and will not be allowed in class. In order to enter the dance room, hair must meet class requirements (bun for ballet and ponytail for all other classes).

During the colder months, dancers are permitted to wear wrap around dance sweaters (pink or black). Sweatshirts and jackets are too bulky and do not allow our teachers to correct form.

For your convenience and to maintain uniformity in class and on stage, the Studio stocks all merchandise.
